MURAL DESCRIPTION:

Interconexiones Sobre la Ciudad (Interconnections Over the City)

The idea behind the expansive mosaic is to highlight Hollywood's past and its look into the future. The overall design represents Old Hollywood, with its art deco and movie poster feeling, with a modern and dynamic approach.

The mural depicts the cityscape as a backdrop to a scene of a 1920's movie premiere, where vehicle with pinstripes is arriving in front of an iconic theater that has a big vertical HOLLYWOOD sign. A pinkish line crosses the artwork horizontally, dividing the image into night and day. At the center top there is a lady as protagonist, with a pearl collar, a white rose, and a triangular earring. She is overlooking the city with a commanding presence, and represents the city of Hollywood in modern times, while giving respect to the old Hollywood movie poster iconography. At the top of the image there are two figures composed in a collaged manner, representing the mixed demographics of Hollywood today, with its colors, liveliness, and style. The three faces together create a triangle that represents equality and inclusiveness. To their left, the TCL Chinese Theater stands tall symbolizing different cultures coming together and to their right, the Castle Argyle is shown with its iconic rooftop signage. The background is composed of a geometric pattern in tones of blues, grays, black, white, and pink, representing the city's diversity and vibrant atmosphere. A secondary pattern, made up of golden lines, crisscrosses the sky, referring to the interconnections that make Hollywood such an important place in Los Angeles.
